



Selling office compensation amounts may appear on all agent and broker websites

On November 19, 2020, the National Association of REALTORS® (NAR) and the U.S. Department of Justice (DOJ) announced that they are in the process of coming to an agreement that will affect how you use CRMLS products and services.

The DOJ has made it clear that all MLSs in California will need to require their systems to give the option to display selling office compensation on all agent and broker websites.

As of Monday, February 15th, CRMLS will give users the option to display selling office compensation amounts on all agent and broker websites.

CRMLS plans to fully comply with the terms of government-mandated agreements, once finalized.
