When CRMLS upgraded your Paragon system, we added new statuses. One of the new statuses is the **Hold** status, which allows you to temporarily remove your listing from an "Active" status without having to cancel it.

Click here to learn more about the Hold status in CRMLS Paragon.

When you enter a listing in the **Hold** status, you must also select a Hold Activation Date. This is the date on which the Hold listing automatically moves to a status of Active.

To help ease the transition into using new statuses, CRMLS has not been automatically moving Hold listings into Active status.

However, to preserve the integrity of CRMLS Paragon data, Hold listings past their Hold Activation Date will automatically become Active on Monday, December 7th.

In addition, from December 7th onward, Hold listings will begin to activate on their Hold Activation Dates
