As of today, May 29, all CRMLS MLS systems will now feature Concessions in Price (CiP) fields. These optional fields will help communicate Seller willingness to offer concessions, giving Sellers an edge and Buyers a clearer idea on a property's cost. Last year, CRMLS recorded nearly 40% of Closed listings included some form of concession, ranging from such seller contributions as payment of broker fees, repair costs, and more. However, this information was only available in the MLS once a listing was Closed. Now, Active listings will feature readily available concessions info to motivate sales and make finding the perfect property that much easier.

If you're on the selling side, you can now market your seller's willingness to consider concessions. If you're on the buying side, you can find listings willing to incentivize a sale and offset financial hurdles. The CiP fields are a win-win.

The new fields are:

- **Concessions in Price:** a text box for numerical input only. This amount should include all potential concessions in a single total amount.
- **Concessions in Price Type:** classify the number above as either \$ or %
- **Seller Consider Concessions?:** either Yes or No. If Yes, then the listing will include the phrase "A Seller may consider a buyer concession if made in an offer."
